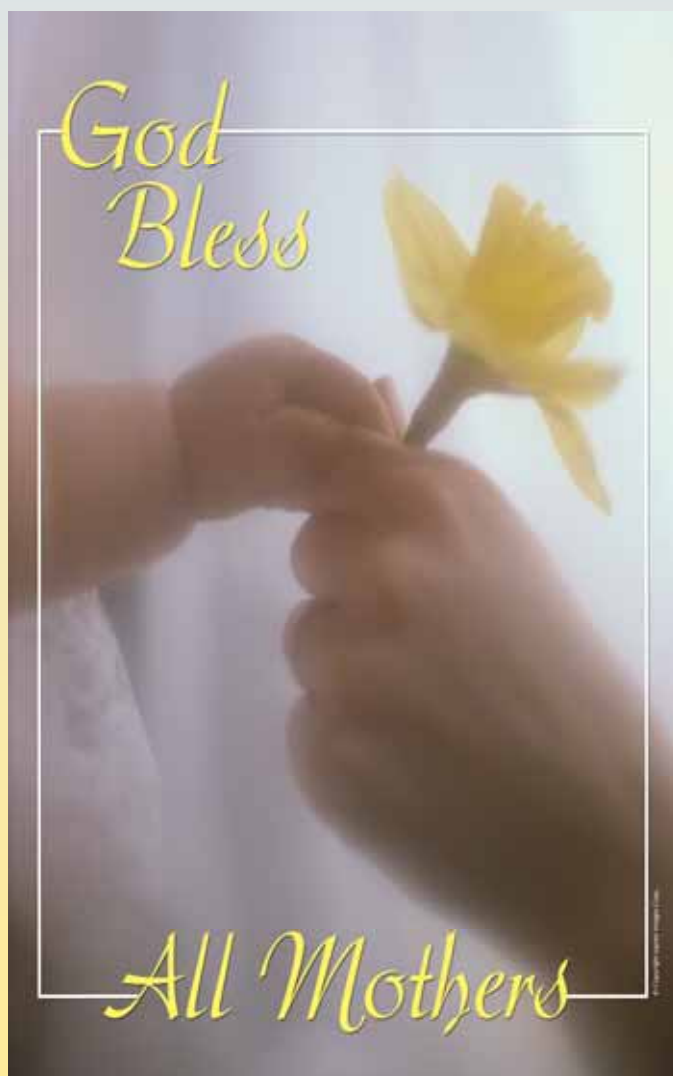
### "AND IT HAPPENED THAT . . ."

Twice in Luke's Gospel today we hear the familiar phrase: "And it happened that..." This seemingly insignificant phrase is huge when used here. The first time is verse 15 as the risen Christ joins the disciples on the road to Emmaus. The second time is verse 30 when he joins them at table and breaks the bread. The monumental impact of these phrases are scarcely felt because of their simplicity.

Yet, each phrase also signals two 'openings' in the passage. The first is the "opening of the scriptures" to the disciples, which will help them realize that through this "breaking open" of God's word their hearts begin to burn with the fire of faith. Second, the breaking of the bread causes their eyes "to be opened," and they recognize Christ. **And so it happens**, each and every Sunday Eucharist, **as it happened** on that "first day of the week" long ago, that in the opening of the word and the breaking of the bread, we come to know Christ in our midst.

The two disciples on the road to Emmaus were having trouble, as do many of us today, finding the presence of Christ in a broken world. The body of their Lord had been broken on a cross. They were confused at the broken seal on the tomb—not yet understanding what it meant—thinking perhaps that the grave had been robbed. Their dreams of the kingdom of God that Jesus had preached were broken. Luke tells us they were "downcast." They were surely not expecting to find God's presence in this stranger on the road whom they did not recognize. But as they continued to listen to his sharing of the scriptures with them on their journey, they yearned to keep him as their companion along the way. At their table he became their host. In the "breaking of the bread" they became aware of Christ present, known, and seen. Their joy overcame any fear of traveling back to Jerusalem after nightfall (a dangerous undertaking in that time and place). They hurried to share their good news. In our own journey with Jesus, we must allow him to open our eyes and set our hearts on fire. Then, overcoming our fears in our faith journey, we can also continue on as messengers of the gospel.

(Summary of Town Hall Meeting January 30, 2011, continued)

What's happened so far?

- \*The two parishes are being served by one pastor
- \*Many parishioners are regularly worshipping at both churches
- \*The Knights of Columbus have been working together on each others' projects - especially monthly breakfasts
- \*The Transition Team has been meeting regularly for the past 18 months
- \*Both Parish Pastoral Councils have begun to meet jointly every month
- \*We have a blended bulletin
- \*Both parishes are work together in the HotDish Hotline program
- \*Youth ministers have created opportunities for our youth to come together
- \*Both parishes have worked to have similar selection process for choosing members for the Parish Pastoral Councils
- \*The Outreach Program is beginning to create a joint effort to help the area food shelves

Questions about Finances?

- \*Our Lady of the Lake is not responsible for helping pay off the debt from the building project at Immaculate Conception
- \*The two parishes will not be merging finances at this time
- \*Immaculate Conception continues it plans for reducing the debt and will initiate another capital campaign in the near future
- \*Parishioners from Immaculate Conception have no expectation that members of Our Lady of the Lake should help pay down the debt

\*Even though our financial concerns will not be merged at this time, it is important that we begin to see ourselves as a single community of faith
