## The World Did Not End!

### THE ASCENSION & STARING INTO THE SKY

Two weeks ago the big news was that the world was going to end. No doubt, a good many people were staring into the sky much like the disciples in today's first reading (Acts 1:1-11). As Christians, we have choices to make with regards to how we journey through life. One choice is to be frozen, like the disciples just as Jesus ascends into heaven. They stand there and stare up into the sky, probably waiting for Jesus to return to them.

Too often we take this stance. We stare into the sky, waiting to discover something to assure us of the presence of the Lord. In reality, this choice will yield few results if any. The angels raise the question: "Why do you stand here looking to the sky?" They try to suggest just how useless such actions are. Two weeks ago we heard of people who had sold everything, quit their jobs, and just waited doing nothing. We haven't heard much about what they are doing now, but rest assured they are probably not looking to the heavens!

Jesus summons us to opt for a different choice. He has us turning our gaze away from the sky to the world around us. He says, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations..." he then assures us of his continued presence: "...and behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19, 20).

It is through the world around us—through those God has planted into our experience—that God will be revealed. Often people who are involved in the Church's work of Christian initiation learn this through their ministry. As they listen to the stories of people who are experiencing deep conversion, they begin to meet the Christ in new ways. It is as if the Lord Jesus is being born again right before their very eyes. Perhaps, in the past you have heard today's gospel mandate and cast it aside saying, "Oh, Jesus really meant those words for the professionals, i.e., priests, deacons, women and men religious, or specially trained lay persons and I'm certainly not one of those." Today's feast is meant for each one of us, laity or ordained.

The Scriptures for the Ascension of the Lord once again remind us that as Christians we are people of hope, and that we are to share that hope with others. St. Paul tells the Ephesians (1:17-23) to enlighten their hearts so that they will know the hope and glory that come from being people who place their trust in the Christ. In the story of the Ascension, as recounted in the first reading, Jesus assures the disciples that the Holy Spirit's power will come upon them. In Matthew's Gospel, the Lord lets the disciples know that their mission is to spread the hope of the gospel to all the nations. Today's feast helps keep our eyes focused on the hope to which we were grounded on the day of our baptism.

Unlike those who were misguided two weeks ago into thinking that the world was going to end and probably staring blankly into the sky, let us open our eyes and hearts to the possibilities of discovering Christ all around us, and by doing so help Christ to continue to unfold the kingdom in our midst.

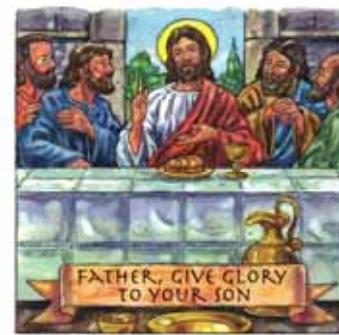

## As Parishes Merge...

*(This is the sixth installment of the Town Hall Meeting on January 30, 2011, and a summary of its minutes.)*

After the presentation we encouraged people to work in small groups and surface question. A number of questions surfaced after the presentation. Note: These are presented here in the order they were received. Fuller clarifications will be addressed in upcoming communications.

*Q. How much debt does Our Lady of the Lake have?*

A. Our Lady of the Lake has no debt. However, there are some building & grounds issues that need to be addressed: the most immediate is the replacement of the windows in the annex, some carpeting in the basement, driveway at the parish house, the air exchange units are currently being replaced as needed. The exterior windows in the church may need improvements in the future.

*Q. What committees are being formed & how does one sign up?*

They are just being formed for people to sign-up. *(See previous bulletins for details.)*

*Q. Who are the members of parish councils & PCCT?*

A. Parish Council members are listed in bulletin. PCCT (Parish Community Coordination Team) or Transition Team will soon be listed along with phone numbers.

*Q. What are short term goals? Is there a 'to-do' list?*

A. We are working phases. Phase one is to evaluate what we have and what do we see needs to be done. Phase two is to begin divided up tasks and working from there.

*Q. Why doesn't Big Lake use Becker's Faith Formation program as a springboard instead of starting a whole new process?*

A. We are still evaluating programming. The FF programs are too big for one person to handle. Location is important. Getting children back & forth with space issues and work schedules is too difficult at this time.

*Q. With the number of priests continuing to decline, will there be another merger down the road—will we be doing this again?*

A. We don't know; no one has a crystal ball. We can only look at what we know now.

*Q. What is taking so long? Let's get going; there is a sense of frustration that the merger is going to slow. Yes, there is a debt; there will always be debt. Let's merge our ministries and merge our families! What's taking so long?*
