As Our Parishes Merge!

Finding a date for the merger — May 19-20, 2012

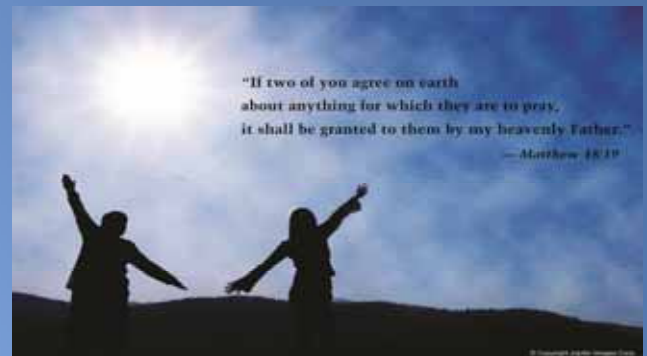
In recent months our parish pastoral councils have been more pro-active in looking at the various issues surrounding the merger of our parishes. One of those concerns is that we must keep this important issue in front of our parishioners at all times. So it will no longer be relegated to the back page of the bulletin; whenever we have something that needs attention, it will be placed right here. Soon all information will be archived for access on the new website that we plan to unveil in a week or two.

Another immediate issue has centered on finding a date for the merger. You may recall that in April 2008 all parishioners received a letter from Bishop John Kinney with the directive that our two parishes would *"be twinned and served by one pastor when either of the current pastors is no longer assigned to one of the parishes. These two parishes will be asked to merge within two years of that time and to create a new parish with a new name but maintain the two existing sites."* In July 2009 Fr. Eb Schefers left Immaculate Conception, and I became pastor of both parishes. Given the bishop's directive our parishes should have been merged by this time.

However, after consulting with the Parish Council and Finance Council from Becker, I visited with Bishop Kinney about the debt situation at Immaculate Conception. At the time, we thought it best to put the merger on hold for a while. Accordingly, a second letter came from the bishop to all parishioners in October 2009 putting the time-line for the merger on hold temporarily.

In the meantime, a Transition Team was created by both parish councils with the task of beginning to deal with matters that would revolve around the merger. This Team did some preliminary groundwork keeping both Parish Councils informed of its work. Yet, it became increasingly clear that we were 'just spinning our wheels' and were not making any progress. A contributing factor to that problem was that we did not have a target date in sight.

In recent months the Parish Councils and the Transition Team have agreed, that to get back on track with the process, we need



to surface a date to help us stay focused. Accordingly, we have requested the weekend of May 19-20, 2012, to mark the celebration of our newly formed parish. As of yet, we have not yet received a confirmation of that date, but we are moving ahead with that date in mind.

A number of things have been happening since this decision was made on the part of our councils. A number of sub-committees have been working hard to create as smooth as possible transition. Ministry scheduling will allow parishioners to serve at either the Becker or Big Lake location. Very soon we will invite parishioners to begin the process of helping to select a new name for ourselves. More Town Hall meetings are being scheduled so that we can share with one another ideas, questions and issues.

One thing we will NOT do is to physically close down either site or even think about physically creating a new worship space. We need to remember what else Bishop Kinney put in that very first letter: *"Within the next six years (of the merger) the parishes would be encouraged to create a worship site with the location to be determined by the parish."*

This is a very exciting time for us! We have the chance that very few people will ever experience in their faith journeys, and that is that we have a great opportunity to create our own future! Stay tuned: Next week the process for choosing a new name will be posted here.

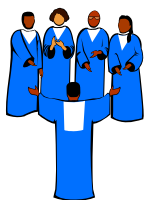

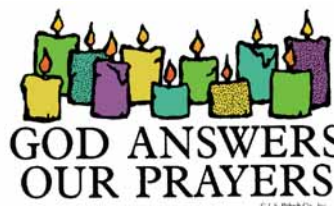
